APPLICATION

COMES NOW the Applicant and shows the Corporation Commission as follows:

1. PARTIES: Applicant is MESA EXPLORATION COMPANY, INC., 4925 Greenville Ave., Suite 200, Dallas, Texas 75206, the owner of the right to inject fluids into the common source of supply named below underlying the lands described in the caption hereof by virtue of a valid and subsisting oil and gas leases owned by Applicant covering said land. The name and address of each party entitled to notice of this Application are as shown on Exhibit "A," attached hereto and made a part hereof.

2. ALLEGATION OF FACTS:

(A) The Ward #6 Enhanced Recovery Injection Well ("Ward") is located in the W/2 W/2 SE/4 SE/4 of Section 22, Township 6 North, Range 3 East, Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma, and has been authorized as an Enhanced Recovery Injection Well ("ERIW") pursuant to Order No. 696459 entered by the Commission on May 21, 2019. Applicant is the owner of the well, is in possession thereof, and is the party authorized to conduct operations therewith.

(B) Applicant does not believe that the Ward will pass the annular mechanical integrity test ("MIT") because, in the last five (5) years, approximately 500 sacks of cement have been pumped into various places up and down the wellbore to squeeze off leaks. Pressuring the pipe might compromise these cement squeeze jobs. At this time, there is cement behind pipe all the way to the surface which has been confirmed by a CBL which will protect the injection zone from communicating with the base of the treatable water.

(C) Operations for the ERIW, in accordance with the parameters set forth under in Order No. 696459, should result in all injected fluids being confined to the permitted Wanette Sand injection zone.

(D) The running of a Radioactive Tracer Survey, in lieu of the Mechanical Integrity Test, will definitively show that all injected fluids are confined to the permitted Wanette Sand injection zone, with the result that the underlying purpose of the Mechanical Integrity Test requirement set forth in OAC 165:10-5-6(b)(2)(F) is satisfied.

(E) The granting of the requested exception or variance to OAC 165:10-5-6(b)(2)(F) for the Ward will allow said well to continue to be used as an Enhanced Recovery



3. LEGAL AUTHORITY: Title 17 O.S. §52, 52 O.S. §139.

4. RELIEF SOUGHT: Applicant requests that, after Notice of Hearing as required by law, it be granted an exception or variance to the terms and provisions of OAC 165:10-5-6(b)(2)(F) by being allowed to run a Radioactive Tracer Survey, in lieu of a Mechanical Integrity Test, for the Ward #6 Enhanced Recovery Injection Well, and for such other and further relief as the Commission deems appropriate under the facts.

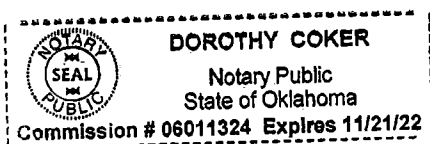
