NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Applicant requests that the Oklahoma Corporation Commission issue an order vacating Order Nos. 511693, 204198 as to the Woodford Shale and Woodford common sources of supply and establishing a 1,280 acre horizontal drilling and spacing unit for the Woodford common source of supply underlying Sections 14 and 23, Township 12 North, Range 9 West, Canadian County, Oklahoma, with the unit being the governmental Sections 14 and 23, providing any horizontal wellbore, from its point of entry and along any part of the lateral hereafter drilled to Woodford common source of supply on the horizontal well drilling and spacing unit established hereby, must be drilled no closer than 165 feet to the north and south unit boundaries and no closer than 300 feet to the east and west unit boundaries and possibly providing that this Order be made effective on a date prior to the signing thereof.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Applicant in this Cause is requesting the following special relief: Vacate Order Nos. 511693, 204198; possibly make the Order effective on a date prior to the signing thereof.

IT IS ORDERED that this Cause be referred to an Administrative Law Judge for hearing, taking of evidence, and for reporting the findings and recommendations to the Commission.
