ORDER OF THE COMMISSION**

- Hearing Date and Place:** 8:30 a.m. before Sean Denton, Administrative Law Judge, on October 14, 2019, Jim Thorpe Building, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
- Appearances:** Jessica D. Hatcher, Attorney, appeared for the Applicant, ROAN RESOURCES, LLC. There were no other appearances and no protests of the matter.
- Notice and Jurisdiction:** Notice has been given by publication as required by Commission Rules and Affidavits of Publication have been filed. Those Respondents whose names and addresses were attainable have been given actual notice by first-class mail pursuant to Commission rules. An adjudicative inquiry was conducted by the Administrative Law Judge into the sufficiency of the search to ascertain the names and addresses of all owners, and if a diligent effort had been made to locate all affected interest owners. The Commission finds that the Applicant has made a meaningful and diligent search of all reasonably available sources at hand to ascertain those parties that are entitled to notice and the whereabouts of those entitled to notice but who were served only by publication. The Applicant gave notice as required, the Commission approves the notice given by mail and by publication, and the Commission has jurisdiction of the subject matter and parties.
- Amendment:** None.
- Relief Requested:** Applicant requests an exception to the horizontal well spacing requirement as stated in OAC 165:10-3-28(c)(2)(B) for the Omaha 28-33-11-7 4WXH well to be closer than 600 feet to the Whirlaway 33-4-11-7 4WXH well.
- Relief Granted:** The requested relief, an exception to Oklahoma Corporation Commission General Rule No. 165: 10-3-28 "General Horizontal Well Requirements," is granted. The horizontal well completion for the Omaha 28-33-11-7 4WXH well in the Mississippian, Woodford, and Hunton common sources of supply shall be allowed to be located closer than 600 feet to the Whirlaway 33-4-11-7 4WXH well.

7. **Reason for Relief:** That Applicant herein is the owner of oil and gas leases underlying said Sections 28 and 33-11N-7W, Canadian County, Oklahoma. Applicant has applied for a well location exception for the Mississippian, Woodford and Hunton common sources of supply for the Omaha 28-33-11-7 4WXH well requesting an exception to an Order No. 671759 and 96482. Applicant believes that the Omaha 28-33-11-7 4WXH well may be located closer than 600 feet from the following wells:

The Whirlaway 33-4-11-7 4WXH, API No. 35-017-25521 which is operated Roan Resources, LLC, located in the SW/4 SE/4 SE/4 NW/4 of Section 33-11N-7W, Canadian County, and produces from the Mississippian, Mississippi Lime, and Woodford common sources of supply;

Applicant will advise at the final hearing whether the wells are within 600 feet from one another.

8. **Companion Causes:** Cause CD Nos. 201903531 and 201903532.

The well location in accordance with the foregoing is necessary to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights and ROAN RESOURCES, LLC. should be permitted to drill and produce the horizontal well as set out herein, provided that this cause is continued until August 10, 2020, to determine the exact location of the well. IT IS SO ORDERED.


