At hearing Ron M. Barnes and Grayson Barnes, Attorneys, appeared for the Movant, Cimarex Energy Co. The Motion for Extension of Time was not protested and the motion was heard uncontested.

The evidence revealed that the Movant intends to drill the well, but due to rig availability has been unable to commence the drilling of the unit well under the time provided in **Order No. 686867**.

Therefore, after reviewing the argument of counsel, the Administrative Law Judge recommended the granting of the Motion.


**ORDER**


