FINAL ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

1. **Hearing Date and Place:** This Cause came on for hearing on June 19, 2017, on June 17, 2019, and on October 7, 2019, before Michael Norris, Administrative Law Judge, pursuant to a Motion to Reopen, at 8:30 a.m., regarding the above-styled Cause, at the Jim Thorpe Office Building, 2101 N. Lincoln Blvd., Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
2. **Appearances:** Jessica D. Hatcher, Attorney, appeared for the Applicant, JONES ENERGY, LLC. There were no other appearances and no protests of this matter.
3. **Companion Causes:** Cause CD No. 201703442.
4. **Notice and Jurisdiction:** Notice has been given by publication as required by Commission Rules and Affidavits of Publication have been filed. Those Respondents whose names and addresses were attainable have been given actual notice by first-class mail pursuant to Commission rules. An adjudicative inquiry was conducted by the Administrative Law Judge into the sufficiency of the search to ascertain the names and addresses of all owners, and if a diligent effort had been made to locate all affected interest owners. The Commission finds that the Applicant has made a meaningful and diligent search of all reasonably available sources at hand to ascertain those parties that are entitled to notice and the whereabouts of those entitled to notice but who were served only by publication. The Applicant gave notice as required, the Commission approves the notice given by mail and by publication, and the Commission has jurisdiction of the subject matter and parties.
5. **Amendment:** At the hearing on October 7, 2019, the Application was amended to reflect the exact location of the well as shown below.
6. **Relief Requested:** An order authorizing an exception to the permitted well location established by Order No. 506362 for the 640-acre drilling and spacing unit formed for the Cleveland common source of supply, underlying the captioned land and granting a full allowable.

The well is to be an open hole completion, using a "packers plus" system.

8. Reason for Relief: The location was selected to drill the well from north to south to encounter the natural fracturing system in the area to enhance production. Applicant drilled a lateral as long as feasible. The location was selected to place the well within the unit to assist in future development. Because of the limited drainage capability and elliptical drainage pattern, no penalty is necessary.


9. Allowable: The allowable is 100% of a normal allowable for the named separate common source of supply.

10. Previous Orders: Emergency Order No. 665940 and Interim Order No. 681420 are superseded by this Order.

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11. **Relief Granted:** The requested relief is granted and is necessary to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights. Applicant is authorized to produce the well as set out herein. IT IS SO ORDERED.






