**ORDER OF THE COMMISSION**

1. Hearing Date and Place: The captioned cause initially came on for hearing on the 8th day of January, 2018, before the Administrative Law Judge for the Corporation Commission of Oklahoma, in the Commission Courtroom, Jim Thorpe Building, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, for the purpose of hearing, taking testimony and reporting findings and recommendations to the Commission. After hearing the arguments of counsel and considering all the facts, evidence and testimony presented in the captioned cause, the Administrative Law Judge recommended that an Interim Order issue in said cause, which Interim Order No. 674559, issued on March 12, 2018.

Thereafter, this matter came on for hearing on September 9, 2019, before Paul Porter, Administrative Law Judge for the Corporation Commission of Oklahoma, in the Commission Courtroom, Jim Thorpe Building, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, for the purpose of hearing, taking testimony and reporting his findings and recommendations to the Commission.

2. Appearances: **Eric Huddleston**, attorney for Applicant.

3. Companion Causes: Application in Cause CD Nos. 201708115, 201708116, 201708117, 201708118, 201708120, 201708121, 201708122, 201708123, 201708124, 201708125, 201708126, 201708127, 201708128, 201708129, 201708130, 201708131, 201708132, and 201708133.

4. Notice and Jurisdiction: Notice has been given by publication as required by Commission Rules and Affidavits of Publication have been filed. Those owners whose names and addresses were attainable have been given actual notice by first-class mail pursuant to Rule 165:5-7-1 and 165:5-7-6. An adjudicative inquiry was conducted by the Administrative Law Judge into the sufficiency of the search to ascertain the names and addresses of all owners and if a diligent effort had been made to locate all affected interest owners. Applicant has made a meaningful and diligent search of all reasonably available sources at hand to ascertain those parties that are entitled to notice and the whereabouts of those entitled to notice but who were served only by publication. The Commission finds the process to be proper and has jurisdiction over the subject matter and the parties.


5. Amendment: None.

6. Relief Requested: Applicant requests that this Commission issue an Order allowing Applicant to situate its Slaughter House 1706 3-36MH well (API 35-073-26028) no closer than 390 feet from the Perdue 1 well (API 35-073-22437), operated by Applicant herein, which well produces from the Mississippi common source of supply, located on the above-described unit.

7. Reason Relief Should Be Granted: The evidence showed that it will take several horizontal wells to fully develop this Section. It is therefore clear that the wells cannot be positioned 600 feet from each other. The evidence further showed that in the absence of the relief requested, the unit would not be fully developed, and there would be waste.

8. Relief Granted: The requested relief is granted. The evidence showed that the Slaughter House 1706 3-36MH well is 545 feet from the Perdue 1 well located on the above-described unit. Said well is targeting the Mississippian (less Chester) common source of supply.


