IT IS THEREFORE THE ORDER of the Corporation Commission of the State of Oklahoma that the Application is dismissed without prejudice.

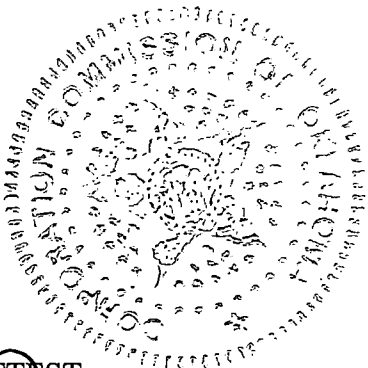


