**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMMENCE WELL  
UNDER WELL LOCATION EXCEPTION INTERIM ORDER NO. 688504**

1. The captioned cause came on for hearing before Michael Norris, Administrative Law Judge for the Corporation Commission, on the 28th day of October, 2019, for the purpose of hearing the Motion for Extension of Time to Commence Well filed by Applicant.

2. The appearances included **Eric Huddleston**, attorney for Applicant.

3. The evidence presented at the time of hearing showed that on the 18th day of December, 2018, pursuant to application and notice filed in the captioned cause, the Commission issued Interim Order No. 688504, authorizing the drilling of an off-pattern well to be located:

**Surface Hole Location:**

the exact surface location has yet to be determined but it is anticipated that it will be a location no closer than 100 feet from the north line and no closer than 500 feet from the east line of Section 32, Township 19 North, Range 25 West, Ellis County, Oklahoma,

**Commencement of Completion Interval in Section 29:**

no closer than 165 feet from the south line and no closer than 500 feet from the east line of Section 29, Township 19 North, Range 25 West, Ellis County, Oklahoma,

**End of Completion Interval in Section 29:**

0 feet from the north line and no closer than 500 feet from the east line of Section 29, Township 19 North, Range 25 West, Ellis County, Oklahoma,

**Commencement of Completion Interval in Section 20:**

0 feet from the south line and no closer than 500 feet from the east line of Section 20, Township 19 North, Range 25 West, Ellis County, Oklahoma,

**End of Completion Interval in Section 20:**

no closer than 165 feet from the north line and no closer than 500 feet from the east line of Section 20, Township 19 North, Range 25 West, Ellis County, Oklahoma,

as to the Cleveland common source of supply, a 640-acre drilling and spacing unit, as an exception to Order Nos. 684540 and 684541.

4. Said Order provides that operations for the drilling of said well shall be commenced within one year from the date of said Interim Order, or said Interim Order shall expire. Applicant is the unit operator and will drill said well permitted by said Interim Order. The granting of this request for an extension of time to commence operations for the drilling of such well will in no way cause prejudice to any interested party.

5. The evidence showed that Applicant had recently drilled an off-set well that was completed in September of 2019, and Applicant wanted at least six months to evaluate the results of that well prior to drilling the subject well. Applicant plans on commencing operations for the subject well within the extended time period. The evidence further showed that Applicant has been unable to commence the subject well and, for good cause shown, should be granted an extension of time to commence said well.

6. After hearing the arguments of counsel and considering all the facts, evidence and testimony presented in the captioned cause, the Administrative Law Judge recommended that the Motion be granted.


**ORDER**

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Corporation Commission of Oklahoma that Duncan Oil Properties, Inc. and/or Trinchera Energy Partners, LLC be and it hereby is granted an additional period of one year from December 18, 2019, or until December 18, 2020, within which to commence the unit well to test the Cleveland common source of supply underlying Sections 29 and 20, Township 19 North, Range 25 West, Ellis County, Oklahoma.

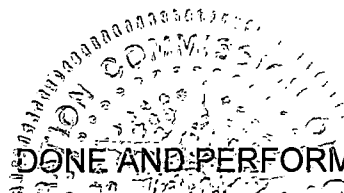
