ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND INTERIM ORDER NO. 688579

The Motion to Extend Order No. 688579 filed by **EOG Resources, Inc., 3817 NW Expressway, Suite 500, Oklahoma City, OK 73112**, in the captioned cause came on for hearing before Administrative Law Judge Michael D. Norris for the Corporation Commission of the State of Oklahoma on October 28, 2019, in the Commission's Courtroom, Jim Thorpe Building, 2101 N. Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, OK 73105, with proper notice of hearing being given, for the purpose of hearing, taking testimony and reporting of findings and recommendations to the Commission.


GREGORY L. MAHAFFEY, Attorney, appeared for Applicant; there were no other appearances and this motion was not protested by any party.

After hearing the arguments of counsel and being fully advised in the premises, the Administrative Law Judge found that good cause had been shown for the relief requested in the Motion to Extend Interim Order No. 688579; Applicant/Movant EOG had two rigs running in Ellis County to drill its Marmaton wells, the Kenai #18 and #19 rigs; the Kenai #18 rig had major mechanical problems, had to be pulled from active service, and is currently being overhauled. The Kenai #19 rig is currently operating in Ellis County and other drilling commitments have delayed drilling of this well. It was the land testimony that notice had been given to operators and non-operators of any new wells drilled in offset units within the past year. The ALJ recommended that said Motion be granted, but only for a period of six (6) months.


ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Corporation Commission of the State of Oklahoma that the Motion to Extend Interim Order No. 688579 filed by **EOG Resources, Inc.** be and the same is hereby GRANTED, and that Applicant be and it is hereby allowed an additional period of six months from **December 19, 2019, or until June 19, 2020**, in which to commence operations for an off pattern well for the Marmaton common source of supply underlying the unit consisting of Section 22, Township 18 North, Range 24 West, Ellis County, Oklahoma, as authorized by Interim Order No. 688579 entered in this cause on December 19, 2018. All other provisions of Interim Order No. 688579 shall remain the same.




