- It was found that Applicant filed an application with the Commission on September 11, 2019, requesting that the prior Order listed below be amended to allow for a change of operator.

- Applicant further submits that the well drilled under and holding Pooling Order No. 602160 is the TDR 12-25-12 1H Well (API No. 35-003-22415). Applicant seeks to change the Operator of the current well, and all subsequent wells drilled pursuant to Order No. 602160.
- The Technical Department of the Oil and Gas Conservation Division of the Commission has reviewed the application and any exhibits. The Commission adopts the following findings of said department.
- Relief Sought: The application requesting authority under OAC OCC 165:5-7-11 to change an operator, appoint an alternate operator or delete the designation of operator in the above mentioned prior Commission Order.
- Jurisdiction: The Commission has jurisdiction of the subject matter and over the application herein.
- Notice: Notice has been given as required by law and the rules of the Commission.
- Adjudication Without Hearing: During the 15-day protest period established by OAC OCC 165:5-7-11, neither the Technical Department nor Applicant received any written protest to the application or demand for hearing. Consequently, the cause was adjudicated on the basis of applicant's verified application and exhibits.

10. Exhibits: The applicant submitted exhibits to the Commission as was referred on the application and notice of hearing, all of which were in compliance with OAC OCC 165:5-7-11.

ORDER

Applicant is hereby authorized and it is hereby so ordered:

1. That a change of operator be effected under Order No. 602160 listed herein deleting Chesapeake Operating, Inc. (now Chesapeake Operating, LLC) and Chesapeake Exploration, LLC and naming BCE-Mach LLC as Operator of the current well, the TDR 12-25-12 1H Well, and all subsequent wells drilled pursuant thereto.
